**PROFILE OF BHARATHI VIDYAPEETH PUNE'**

The Directorate of Distance Education was established by Bharati Vidyapeeth University in Aug. 2003. In its initial year i.e. 2003-04 about 120 students registered. For the year 2004-05 more programmes have been added. The programmes on offer are of two different types.

Programmes under external mode with supportive personal contact sessions / study material, made available at the centres and Programmes under purely external mode. In which case there are no contact sessions or supply of supportive learning material. The arrangement for one to one academic counselling is made. The Academic Centres are well equipped with learning resources supported with availability academic counseling. This works as an important motive for a learner to learn and to remain student throughout his life. The programmes on offer provide need for certification and improvement of skills by the learners. They equip the learners with additional professional qualifications and provide them opportunities for self enrichment. A learner need not discontinue either vertical education ladder or give up current job. The opportunity for knowledge upgradation that a learner gets through these programmes help to increase his personal employability and human capital.

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

The Information brochure (together with application form for admission) is available at the Office of the Centre. The seats at each Centre are restricted.

For all other programmes the candidate shall apply in the prescribed form attached with the Bharathi Prospectus. On verification of the eligibility for admission, the candidate will be informed about the selection. He/She will be asked to complete the eligibility requirement by sending following **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS FOR VERIFICATION AND RETURN.**

- 1) Passing Certificate of the qualifying exam. (either HSC or Bachelor/Masters degree)
- 2) Statement of Marks for above exam.
- 3) Migration Certificate. (only for candidates passing Bachelor's /Master's degree from other Universities) Jr. College Leaving Certificate or Transfer Certificate from the College last attended (for candidates seeking admission to degree programme only).
- 4) Character Certificate (for degree programmes only).

After checking the original certificates, the student is finally registered and gets an Identity Card

## **EXAMINATION APPLICATION**

The fee prescribed for different examinations will have to be paid separately as per University notification at that time. Normally applications for Nov/Dec University exams are filled in July/August and for April/May exams in Jan/Feb.

### **Conditions :**

The admission to degree, diploma programme will be made twice in the academic year viz in May/June i.e in the First Term and in Nov/Dec. i.e in the Second Term. The duration of programme will begin from the said term.

A candidate desirous of seeking admission to any notified programme must have passed (a) the said qualifying examination with requisite percentage of marks prescribed (b) have cleared the Entrance Test prescribed by the University (BBA, BCA) (c) and fulfill other conditions.

A candidate must be of sound mind and must have completed 18 years of age as on the date of admission.

The candidate after admission will be assigned to Academic Centre of his/her choice through which a student will get services such as counselling, library and Lab facilities. The internal evaluation and University exams will be conducted at that Centre only. The Centre is allowed to arrange or rearrange the schedule for personal contact sessions/seminars. If the strength for a particular programme is below expectation, the programme will be conducted centrally at New Delhi or Pune.

A candidate after admission shall be treated as registered student of the University and will be governed by the rules and regulations made by the University or the Academic Centre or authorities such as State, Central Govt, UGC etc. in respect of discipline, examinations and the like.

Admission cannot be claimed as a matter of right.

The Director, Distance Education or the Controller of exams is not responsible for the loss of or the delay in the delivery of postal articles sent by them.

In case of any dispute the decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final.

### **Personal Contact sessions /seminars**

The PCS will be conducted at the Academic Centres during holidays (including Sunday's or Saturdays and public holidays). Normally during a Term for degree there will be 25 to 40 hours devoted to these sessions for theory as well as practical work.

For diploma there will be one seminar in each term.

**Fees** The fees are payable in full at the time of seeking admission. The University examination fee will have to be paid separately along with filling of examination form. The above fee rates are for Indian nationals for NRI or foreign students the eligibility fee will be US \$ 200 and 5 times Curricular transactions fee. Fees once paid shall not be refunded.

**In addition to fees the students shall be required to incur their own expenses in connection with project work, field visits, professional seminars etc.**

The well turned out men and women at hotels and restaurants, who present themselves with polite manners and a magnetic smile, never fail to put us at ease. They are all professional, working day and night to keep in operations, the 'Hospitality Industry,' Being part of a glamorous industry.' that has grown gigantically in recent times with Tourism and Corporate activity, Hotel management professionals actually have a lot to smile about. The field offers scope for diverse experiences and the professionals are driven by the mission of coordinating all efforts to ensure optimum guest comfort and satisfaction. HOSPITALITY, ONE OF THE LARGEST INDUSTRIES IN TERM OF MANPOWER EMPLOYED IS NOT ONLY PEOPLE DEPENDANT BUT PEOPLE-ORIENTED TOO. The entire gamut of Tourism operations does not deal with tangible saleable products like tasty food and comfortable beds only. The human warmth which surrounds every product like a halo is not seen- but felt and is the corner stone of such operations.

Over the years, the graph of tourist movement – both domestic and international-Kept on showing an upwardly mobile direction, as a result the hotel or the hospitality education came up. The vast potential of India's multifaced grandeur who identified by the national builders after independence and the need for professionally trained manpower was established. Hotel/hospitality education came into existence then.

Within a span of 40 years the services in the hotel in India have gained a reputation though out the world with some of them featuring in the list of world's best hostels every year. A multibillion-dollar industry hospitality is our country's third largest industry employing 9.5 million people annually. The hospitality industry is defined as the activity of providing lodging, fooding, beverage and recreational services, which include hotels, motels, clubs, casinos, restaurants, recreational facilities, tourism, cruise lines them parks. The options available in this industry are eye-catching. The history of the hospitality industry dated back all the way to the colonial period, when in 1874 the first city hotel opened in New York City. Things have changed quite a bit and the hospitality industry has experienced significant development over the years as it has faced the World Wars, the depression and various social changes. The industry as we know in India today began to take form in the early 1950's leading the way for growth into the dynamic industry. Career options into the hospitality industry have continued to grow with the industry. There are different descriptions, which outline the different levels of hospitality positions. The first is the entry level where in an initial experience and skill is gained and which in turn can help in the advancement of the career. The task given here are related to the positions and acts as a valuable component to the success of the hospitality entity.

The next level is the skilled level, where more stress is given on enhancing specific skills and capabilities, which can be used as a ladder to climb the pillar of success. The third level can see a more mature blend of experience, training and initiative which when combined creates an ability to lead employees and manage business. So this level is called Managerial level. There are enormous career opportunities which can be obtained in the hospitality industry.

There are multiple choices in the hospitality industry. This industry demands that the person should be a good worker, having positive attitude, with food communication skill, having an ability to sacrifice. While under training a hospitality professional is inculcated appearance with the professional appearance and ability to work under pressure. Although these qualities may seem simple they are constantly being put to the test due to the request of the people serve by this very demanding industry.

Regardless of the work within hospitality there is always a rise in guests/customer's expectation and where in the professionals have to ensure that the guests experience is pleasant and memorable. After getting a job in the hospitality industry position and money flows upwards people are well compensated after the successful completion of the job. Today wages for hospitality are very competitive as compared to those of other industry. A wide ranges of salaries are available in this industry. Several elements beginning with capability/skill and performance well impact the income. The industry is becoming increasing complex with a greater emphasis being placed on specialize

training. Demand is increasing with special skills obtained in colleges, technical institutes, vocational schools. Programs range in length from a few months to several years. Nearly 200 community and junior colleges offer 2-year degree programmes in hotel and restaurant management. It is possible to obtain a 4-year college degree in the liberal arts or other fields and enter into a trainee or junior management track. However, a bachelor's and master's degree programmes in hotel and restaurant management provides the strongest background, for a career as a hotel manager, with nearly 150 colleges and universities offering programmes in India. Graduates of these programmes are highly sought by employers in this industry. New graduates often go through on-the-job training programmes before being given much responsibility. Eventually, they can advance to a top management position in a large chain operation.

### **Travel & Tourism**

Travel and Tourism is considered to be the largest services-based industry in the world. Tourism is the largest foreign exchange earner among all industries, and provides direct employment to lakhs of people. This industry exists in private as well as public sectors in the segments in this field of travel agents and tour operators.

Travel agents deal with the marketing of travel and tourism planning and selling trips to individual or groups. Tour operators are engaged in travel and destination management.

Public sector deals with the promotion of tourism in India. Therefore, most public sector organizations in this field run a network of hotels, information centers and other facilities and services for visitors to the country, besides being involved in development of tourism infrastructure and expanding the industry. Railways, airline carriers, Department of Tourism India, Tourism Development Corporation and State Tourism Development Corporations assist these organizations.

#### **Attributes**

Those wishing to enter the travel and tourism industry have to be enterprising. Candidates should have drive and the capacity for hard work, since achievement is the key to success in this industry. Work in this industry involves dealing with people. Travel company personnel should be aware of the current rules and regulations and documentation that goes into passport and visa and so on. All staff in marketing, counter sales, or guide services, should be aware of the general background, air, road and rail connections and facilities available at the place their clients visit.

#### **Eligibility**

Those seeking an entry into the field can either join a travel agency or a tour operating company or take up a position in a government department or corporation. New entrants are given on-the-job training. However, a basic diploma in travel and tourism management will be advantageous. Students of 10th can take 11th, 12th Maharashtra board, 10+2 pass students can pursue a Diploma or Bachelor's degree programmes in hotel management to gain professional training. Most hotel management institutes test students through a written examination on English, reasoning, general science and general knowledge, followed by a group discussion and interview. The final year of the courses sees students specializing in their area of interest and aptitude whether it be front office, FOOD AND BEVERAGE, HOUSEKEEPING OR FOOD PRODUCTION, all of which are major departments in a hotel. Operations, engineering, security, marketing, public relations, finance and IT are other departments to specialists that these openings to specialists in these respective spheres. Each department has its own precise tasks and provides necessary training in the initial years to equip the fresher.

### **STATUS OF HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT EDUCATION IN INDIA**

In India currently there are 1393007 managers, 2070700 supervisors and 12800077 staff, all 3 categories totaling to 16272100 employees in 1722 star category hotels (from 1 to 5 star deluxe) in the hotel industry in India.

There is a requirement of about 1,50,000 additional trained persons in the star category hotels in India, which includes about 270,000 managers, about 2,500,000 supervisors and about 10,00,000 staff member and supervisor categories which totals to 52,00,000 and will be filled by 3 to 4 years diploma and degree holders. In 1 star, government approved/unapproved hotels, restaurants and other catering establishments, it is estimated that there is an additional requirement every year for about 750,000 diploma/degree holders in the country and about 15,00,000-20,00,000 one-year certificate holders.

### AIR HOSTESS / FLIGHT STEWARD-REQUIRED 20,284 BY 2011-12.

The trouble free, comfortable and safe journey of a passenger is of prime importance to the aviation sector. In this regard, it is an Air Hostess / Flight Steward whose role becomes really crucial as they are the first one to welcome passengers aboard an aircraft.

Their efficiency and effectiveness are critical factors to any airline's growth. They help the passengers to find their seats and put cabin luggage in the luggage chambers. They give instructions to the passengers about how to operate the air flow system, knobs above one's seat and how to call them in time of need.

Their job also includes giving instructions to the passengers on how to use safety measures during crisis, catering foods and drinks to the passengers and answering passengers' inquiries on facilities and services. They are supposed to provide First Aid to passengers who feel sick.

Above all, keeping an eye on comfort of passengers like adjusting seat inclination, setting pillow under someone's head, helping passengers in time of crisis like emergency landing, crash landing, etc. to cope with the situation and disembark fast from aircraft, etc., are also an art of Air Hostess/ Flight Steward's job.

By the count, the various airlines in the country have almost 10,207 Cabin Crew members in 2007-08 and the number is expected to grow to almost 20,284 by 2011-12.

### Aptitude:

To be an Air Hostess or a Flight Steward, one should have common sense, sense of responsibility, initiative quality, friendly outgoing personality, politeness, physical stamina and the capacity to work for long hours on the feet.

The ability to react quickly in time of emergency, presence of mind, systematic approach, unruffled appearance, a well-modulated pleasant voice and a proportionate figure with a graceful carriage are the important traits required in an Air hostess or a Flight Steward.

The selection of cabin crew is based on round of interviews in groups and individual but ultimately, medical fitness cannot be ignored in the selection.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

**THE EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION FOR AN AIR HOSTESS / FLIGHT STEWARD TRAINING PROGRAMME IS 10+2 OR A GRADUATE DEGREE WITH A DIPLOMA / DEGREE IN HOTEL MANAGEMENT OR TOURISM MANAGEMENT.** The aspirant must be eligible to hold an Indian Passport and should be below twenty-five years of age with proportionate weight and height.

Further, one must be unmarried, with normal eyesight of 6/6 increased vision in each eye. Fluency in English, Hindi and knowledge of an international language is an added advantage.

## **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

The applicant should be physically fit with a pleasing personality and clear complexion. After the initial screening of applicants is completed, the airline company calls them for a **WRITTEN EXAMINATION, ON TOURISM AND HOTEL MANAGEMENT** . usually of the **OBJECTIVE TYPE (MULTIPLE CHOICE)**.

Those who qualify in the written examination have to appear for a **GROUP DISCUSSION** followed by a **PERSONAL INTERVIEW** of successful candidates. If selected, the applicant will be on training for two to three months in which one can learn about service, grooming, safety and first aid, after which one is initially put on trainee flights.

## **Flight Training**

The flight training covers several topics, each of which deals with technical or nontechnical aspects of the aircraft.

Beginning with the history of aviation, the candidates are made to learn in-flight service, passenger handling, passenger psychology, service of meals on the aircraft, the art of conversation, transactional analysis, emergency evacuation system, personal grooming and hygiene, First Aid, confidence building, handling of visually impaired passengers, making announcements, emergency demonstration, etc.

There is a great demand for Air Hostesses/Flight Stewards in the Aviation sector. They can find employment with private owned domestic and international airlines namely Singapore Airlines, Jet Airways, etc. and government air services like Air- India.

  - Facility to apply the knowledge and skills to the effective delivery of the projects/functions assigned to him/her.

**Eligibility**

Any of the **XTH/HSC PASS** in any branch from a recognized Board with atleast 55 percent marks in the qualifying exam.

**Duration**

The Program duration is 24 months / 2 years . It is organized as STD XI in first year and STD XII **MAHARASHTRA BOARD EXAM** in the second year.

**Seats**

- i. Each Programme has 20 seats only .
- ii. Reserve quota candidates to be considered as per rules applicable at the time of admission.
- iii. Few seats in each Program cab be reserved for Overseas Students.
- iv. The Foundation reserves the right to convert the unfilled reserve category seats into open general category or not fill them at all at its sole discretion.

**Admission Procedure**

- i. Admission to the Program is done on merit and on all India basis.
- ii. Direct admission is granted to top 8 percent students of all examining boards who seek it..
- iii. Those interested in admission should submit applications on the prescribed forms to the Institute alongwith the required documents within the specified dates. Incomplete applications may not be considered.
- iv. All eligible candidates are invited to undergo the selection procedure and interviews with the Selection Committee.
- v. A merit list is drawn on which all competing candidates appear in the order of their respective merit.

## **Hostel**

Students who require hostel accommodation are assisted to find it at places not far from the Institute.

## **Fees and Payment Schedule**

The total amount of fees payable for any of the Programs over 24 months is payable in instalments to selected students only. In addition, a deposit of Rs.10,000 is to be paid at the time of admission.

The fees includes admission fee, Registration fee, Examination fee ,computer Practical, contributions to library and students welfare fund.

All other charges:fees for computer Workshop, site visits, Fees are payable Extra

The instalments for few selected students are Payble at every months interval

The following conditions apply to payment of fees and other dues.

- i. Fees once paid are non-refundable.
- ii. The deposit will stand forfeited if a student, after having been enrolled, leaves studies in-between for any reason whatsoever or fails to complete the studies successfully.
- iii. Fees are payable by Demand Draft drawn in favour of "" and payable at any bank . Personal cheques and cash are not accepted.
- iv. The fees and other dues payable at the time of admission are mentioned in the Admission Letter itself.
- v. The Fees are payable as per the schedule given. Late fee @ Rs. 10 for every day of delay. from the stipulated date will be levied upto 10 days and thereafter the studentship may be cancelled. Hostel fee is additional.

## **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

The following types of financial help is available.

- i. Assistance for bank loans to those who seek it.
- ii. SBCC offers :
  - a. Eight loan scholarship, interest free, covering 50 percent of fees payable, amount to be repayed within 4 years of the date of passing exam.
  - b. Four merit scholarships of Rs. 2500/- per month to students who top the PLACEMENT SUPPORT TRAINING PROGRAM at the end of 2nd Year i.e Std XII , for one year (covering PLACEMENT SUPPORT TRAINING PROGRAM).
  - c. A limited number of PLACEMENT SUPPORT /Assistantships should normally be available from 2nd semester of 2nd year onwards.
  - d. Companies normally pay stipends to trainees during 4 months of internship.

Those who wish to be considered for any type of financial assistance may fill the form alongwith the Application for Admission to courses.

## **ACADEMIC DESIGN**

The intent of all four Programs of studies is to go beyond creating narrow specialists and primarily skills oriented professionals. These Programs will build a broader understanding of the Hospitality world and give exposure to several areas, while imbibing skills relevant to the current and emerging era. Accordingly, and broadly complying with the DGVET guidelines in this regard, the academic design of the courses is a judicious mix of Foundation courses , Basic Management Practice Courses, and Courses on Methods & Techniques of subjects being studied in the 2 year are common to all Programs.

Specialised learning takes place in the second year, specialised field work and practical Journal preparation & Internship are also in specialised fields.

i. Grading System

Evaluation will be on Semester basis. At the end of every Semester, a Performance Index (PI) and Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) will be calculated. The CPI at the end of any semester must not fall below 6.0. A student is permitted to accumulate a maximum of two failed grades throughout the course. In order to pass the Programme a student should clear all grades.

ii. Examinations

Evaluation will comprise of inclass continuous assessment and examination. The total weightage of inclass continuous assessment will be totaliy . In a specific manner as prescribed by the board of examination \_MAHARASHTRA BOARD which will decide the exact evaluation pattern of the course..**AWARD** Students who are assessed to have met all the academic requirements successfully are eligible to receive their Certificates.

In order to qualify for the Award, the student should meet successfully the following requirements:

- i. Minimum prescribed attendance of 75 percent in each course.
- ii. Minimum of 8 credit points in each course.
- iii. Satisfactory completion of Internship.
- iv. Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) of 6.0.
- v. "No dues payable" certificate from the all the concerned departments of the Institute.
- vi. Fulfillment of the code of conduct.

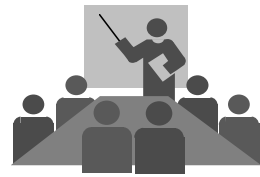

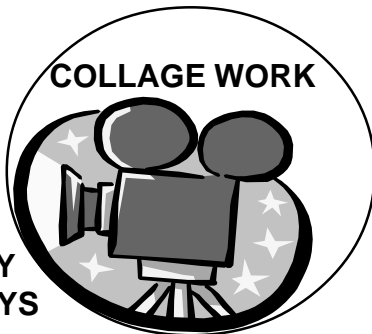
